**72 hour Secure Flight Passenger Data (SFPD) requirement/Honorific
Titles for passengers on US Bound flights.**

Forwarding you a self explanatory trailing email from Security reiterating the need for inserting Secured Flight Data and Honorific Titles for all passengers travelling on US bound flights

The insertion of Secured Flight Data (SSR DOCS, DOCO, DOCA) in all PNRs for travel into, out of or over the USA is mandatory as per the directives of US Department of Homeland Security, and it is extremely important and necessary that all agencies are advised of this requirement.

Please disseminate this information urgently to all offices and travel agents under your jurisdiction and ensure this information is entered into all existing bookings. At the time of pre-flight checks prior to D-3 days, if this information has not been entered, the PNR will have to be cancelled. This may please be conveyed in writing to all travel agents under your jurisdiction.

Any bookings made within D-3 days will have to have this information at the time of creation of the PNR as this information will be sent automatically to the US Department of Homeland Security on the end of PNR creation.

Currently the AI Reservations system does not reject bookings without this information. Therefore it is absolutely essential that stations check all bookings on the India – USA – India flights and ensure this information has been entered.

If any passenger travels without this information in the PNR, the fine levied by the US Department of Homeland Security will have to be debited to the agent responsible for the booking.

This information i.e. SSR DOCS, DOCO, DOCA should also be inserted 3 days prior to departure for all SOL and SOD passengers travelling to and from USA
