Guidelines for International arrivals in India -This Standard Operating Procedure shall be valid w.e.f. 12th November 2021 (00.00 Hrs IST) till further orders

All travelers should submit self-declaration form on the online Air Suvidha portal before the scheduled travel

Self Declaration Form through <u>https://www.newdelhiairport.in/airsuvidha/apho-registration</u>

Upload a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR report. This test should have been conducted within 72 hrs prior to undertaking the journey.

Each passenger shall also submit a declaration with respect to authenticity of the report and will be liable for criminal prosecution, if found otherwise

They should also give an undertaking on the portal or otherwise to Ministry of Civil Aviation, Government of India, through concerned airlines before they are allowed to undertake the journey that they would abide by the decision of the appropriate government authority to undergo home quarantine/ self-health monitoring, as warranted.

All passengers shall be advised to download Aarogya Setu app on their mobile.

Travellers arriving from Bangladesh irrespective of their COVID-19 vaccination status (Not vaccinated / Partially vaccinated) need to undertake the following measures :

• Submission of sample for post-arrival COVID-19 test at the point of arrival after which they will be allowed to leave the airport,

• Home quarantine for 7 days,

• Re-test on the 8th day of arrival in India and if negative, further self-monitor of their health for next 7 day

\* Children under 5 years of age are exempted from both pre- and post-arrival testing. However, if found symptomatic for COVID-19 on arrival or during home quarantine period, they shall undergo testing and treated as per laid down protocol.

\*\* 15 days must have elapsed since completion of COVID-19 vaccination schedule

Thermal screening would be carried out in respect of all the passengers by the health officials present at the airport. The self-declaration form filled online shall be shown to the airport health staff.

The listing of Countries is available on websites of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare (mohfw.gov.in) and the link of the same will be available at website of Ministry of External Affairs and Air Suvidha Portal. This is also a dynamic list and will be updated from time to time.
