1. Issued for Spouse or Child of Japanese National  
(Visa Category: (S)AS SPOUSE, CHILD OF JAPANESE)
2. Issued for Spouse or Child of Permanent Resident  
(Visa Category: (S)AS SPOUSE OF PERMANENT RESIDENT)
3. Issued for Diplomacy  
(Visa Category: (D)AS DIPLOMAT)

**※Attention:** Visa issued to spouses of Japanese nationals for the purpose of temporary visit or short stay (Visa Category: (V)AS TEMPORARY VISITOR) are suspended its validity.

4. VISA issued after 02DEC (including all stays / including issued 02DEC)

**5. Resident Card Holder (all status)**

\*If pax has a valid re- entry permit.

**• Re-entrants with status of residence and valid re entry permit**

The re-entry into Japan of foreign nationals with status of residence who have stayed in Eswatini, Zambia, Zimbabwe, Namibia, Botswana, Malawi, South Africa, Lesotho, Angola, Mozambique, Democratic Republic of Congo within 14 days prior to the application for landing will be denied from 12 DEC, 2021

**• Seaman –are allowed to enter Japan.**

**All of India are subject to 3 days quarantine in the Government accommodation.**

**/// Quarantine after entry ///**

**(1) Present inspection certificate**

- At the time of entry, present a certificate or a copy of certificate of pre-entry test issued within 72 hours prior to departure and certified as "negative" by the local medical institution to the quarantine officer.

**(2-1) Quarantine in the accommodation of the government is required (from 17JAN22)**

**From all of India**

- **Passenger will be tested for Covid-19 at the airport and third day mandatory quarantine in the accommodation (the date of entry into Japan is not included ) after the time of arrival in Japan.**

- On the third day after pax entry to the accommodation (the date of entry into Japan is not included), passenger will be tested again. If the result is negative, he/she will leave the accommodation.
- After leaving the accommodation, pax must remain at home, etc. for 10 days after entering Japan.
- If pax do not follow the instructions of the quarantine officer, he/she may be detained in accordance with the Quarantine Act.

**(3) Submit written pledge**

- Passenger needs to submit a written pledge to remain at home, etc. for 10 days after arrival, not to use public transportation and to report health conditions using the application, etc., to store their location information using a map application function, send their location information to Health Monitoring Center for Overseas Entrants upon their request , etc.
- If pax violate the pledge, their (name and nationality if pax are non-Japanese) and information that contributes to the prevention of the spread of infection may be publicized.
- In addition to the above if passenger are a non- Japanese, he/she may be subject to revocation of status of residence and deportation etc. under the provisions of the Immigration Control and Refugee Recognition Act in case of the violation.
