



## **Restoration and Extension of Singapore's Vaccinated Travel Lanes**

Dear Trade Partners

Singapore Airlines (SIA) welcomes the latest restoration and expansion of Singapore's Vaccinated Travel Lane (VTL) arrangements.

In tandem with this expansion, and as part of a broader expansion of its VTL services, SIA will progressively add Dubai, Hong Kong, Manila, New York (Newark), and Phuket to its VTL network from 25 February 2022.

Please refer to our dedicated VTL page<sup>1</sup> for the start date for the various VTL flights.

SIA will also step up frequencies for flights between Singapore and several existing VTL destinations. These are Bandar Seri Begawan, Colombo, Male, and Phnom Penh.

Scout, SIA's low-cost subsidiary, will include Chiang Mai, Cebu, Clark, Davao, Hong Kong, Jeddah, Krabi, London (Gatwick), and Phuket to its VTL network. It will also increase the frequency for its flights between Singapore and Phuket.

The SIA Group has seen strong demand for its VTL services since the launch of these arrangements last year. We will continue to grow our network and add new services in a calibrated manner, providing greater travel options and flexibility for our customers.

### **Key Conditions of VTLs**

The following changes will also apply for travellers entering Singapore from 21 February 2022, 2359 hours (Singapore time).

- Travel history requirement will be reduced from 14 to 7 days.
  - VTL travellers must have remained only in (including any transit stops) one or more of the VTL countries/regions, or a country/region in Category I of MOH's Country/Region Classification for Border Measures in the last 7 consecutive days prior to departure to Singapore. If the traveller has been in Singapore within those last 7 days, his/her stay in Singapore can be counted towards fulfilling this 7-day travel history requirement.
- Long-Term Pass Holders (except work permit holders) will no longer have to apply for a Vaccinated Travel Pass (VTP) to travel to Singapore on a VTL flight.

## **Changes to On-Arrival Testing for Singapore**

The enhanced 7-day testing regime for arriving VTL travellers will cease for those entering Singapore from 21 February 2022, 2359 hours (Singapore time). In addition, VTL travellers will no longer need to perform an on-arrival Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test at Changi Airport. Instead, they will have up to 24 hours from their entry into Singapore to take a supervised self-swab (SSS) Antigen Rapid Test (ART) at one of the testing centres located across Singapore.

The weblink to book a test will be provided in the Testing Notice issued to travellers on arrival in Singapore. Except for going for the SSS, travellers are required to isolate in their accommodation until they have tested negative on the supervised ART.
