Dear Trade and Travel Partners of India,

SUB: Revised conditions of acceptance to Bahrain

Please note that with immediate effect **WHO approved vaccinated** passengers to Bahrain will **NOT** require **RTPCR test** report or **Quarantine adherence**, before boarding flights from India. However, the RTPCR test on arrival, 5th and 10th day will continue to take place at Bahrain.

Fully **vaccinated*** passengers means those who have completed 2 weeks after the last dose of vaccines.

Vaccines approved by **WHO** are Moderna, Pfizer-BioNtech, Janssen (Johnson & Johnson), Oxford – AstraZeneca, **Covishield – AstraZeneca**, Sinopharm , Sinovac & **Covaxin**
