Dear Trade and Travel Partners of India,

Please note the revised Terms and Conditions for Acceptance of Passengers to Bahrain with immediate effect.

1. Bahraini Nationals / Residents and Indian Nationals holding any type of valid Visa from the Kingdom of Bahrain and destined to Bahrain only
2. Passengers with a valid e-visa granted prior to boarding
3. Airline crew, Diplomats and military personnel
4. All other passengers are permitted to transit through BIA, **except from India**; maximum allowable transit time in BAH is 12 hrs.
5. Passenger categories and requirements to complete.

Vaccinated and Recovered in Bahrain, GCC & countries with mutual recognition (Hungary, Cyprus, Greece, Israel & Seychelles)	Upon arrival	N/A	Need to present vaccination or immunity status through certificate in paper or official mobile app with QR code which are approved by Bahrain MOH, WHO
Recently Recovered Passengers (above 06 years of age)	Upon arrival		Need to present Recovery Certificate or a positive PCR test taken no later than 14days prior to departure and no earlier than 30days prior to departure
Vaccinated passenger holding a valid certificate issued by public health authorities & eligible for VOA facility	Upon arrival	N/A	1. Need to present vaccination certificate in paper or official mobile app with QR code which are approved by Bahrain MOH, WHO. 2. Check eligibility for VOA through www.evisa.gov.bh

Non-vaccinated or passengers without a vaccination certificate approved by Govt. of Bahrain	Upon arrival	10days Precautionary quarantine at place of residence	Passengers must provide proof of a residence either owned or leased by PAX or an immediate family member before boarding
Transit Passengers through Kingdom of Bahrain from Non Red- list countries.	N/A	N/A	Must meet all requirements of final destination

Note:

- a. Fully vaccinated passenger's means those who have completed 2 weeks after the last dose of vaccines.
- b. Vaccines approved by WHO are Moderna, Pfizer-BioNtech, Janssen (Johnson & Johnson), Oxford – AstraZeneca, Covishield – AstraZeneca, Sinopharm , Sinovac & Covaxin
- c. Passengers (below 6years of age): exempted from testing & quarantine requirements
- d. All cost associated with testing must be borne by passengers.

Terms and Conditions:

- Refunds and date change charges as per applicable GDS fare rule
- Passengers need to report Three (3) hours before departure
- Carton boxes / Baggage of irregular size will not be accepted
- All passengers to wear Face Masks / shield through the flight
- Minimum Connecting Time (MCT) when transiting Bahrain should be within 12Hrs
