Subject: Vaccination certificate instruction for entry into Kingdom of Thailand

Dear Chairman, Airline Operators Committee Bangkok and Don Mueang

Attached docs: 1. Approved list of vaccine by The Ministry of Public Health Thailand
2. Vaccination Criteria for Travelers Entry into Thailand

According to the change of Thailand's entry requirements effective from 1st July 2022, passengers entering the Kingdom of Thailand need to provide either a vaccine certificate which indicates full vaccinations as required by The Department of Disease Control, Ministry of Public Health Thailand, or a negative test result of a professional rapid antigen test/ RT-PCR.

The acceptance guidelines for fully vaccinated passengers are as follows:

1. The vaccine certificate must be in **English or Thai**.
2. The vaccine certificate must indicate
 - 2.1 **The passenger identification (ID)** including **Passenger Name** and **Passport Number**, or **Date of Birth** AND
 - 2.2 **The vaccine information** including **accredited vaccine name** (see attached document) and **date of vaccination**.
3. **The full vaccination criteria are as follows:**
 - 3.1 **Persons over 18 years old** must complete required doses of vaccine regimens, and the last dose must be taken more than 14 days before departure from the originating country.
 - 3.2 **Persons aged 5-17** must have at least one dose of vaccination, and the first dose of vaccination must be more than 14 days before departure from the originating country.

4. Special circumstances

4.1 Children


- a) **Child under 6 years of age** is exempted from vaccination and lab testing but must travel with parents or guardians.
- b) **Child under the age of 18** can travel alone as an unaccompanied minor (UMNR), if the child has received one dose of vaccination or holds a negative RT-PCR or Pro-ATK test results (within 72 hours before departure from the originating country)
- c) **Child under the age of 18** travel with fully vaccinated parent or guardian is exempted from vaccination and lab testing

4.2 COVID-19 recovery status

- a) For passengers with COVID-19 recovery between 14 - 90 days after the first date of symptom or first date of the positive test; no vaccination is needed.
- b) If a passenger holds a Covid-19 recovery certificate, which lasts longer than 90 days, a single dose of vaccine will be accepted as being fully vaccinated.

We sincerely hope that these protocols will provide all airlines with clear instructions on passenger acceptance.

Vaccination Criteria for Travelers Entry into Thailand



1. Fully Vaccination Definition

- a. Persons over 18 years old must complete required doses of vaccine regimens, and the last dose must be taken more than 14 days before departure from the originating country.
- b. Persons aged 5 - 17 must have at least one dose of vaccination, and the first dose of vaccination must be more than 14 days before departure from the originating country.

2. Children

- a. Child under 6 years of age is exempted from vaccination and lab testing but must travel with parents or guardians.
- b. Child under the age of 18 can travel alone as an unaccompanied minor (UMNR), if the child has received one dose of vaccination or holds a negative RT-PCR or Pro-ATK test results (within 72 hours before departure from the originating country)
- c. Child under the age of 18 travels with fully vaccinated parent or guardian is exempted from vaccination and lab testing

3. COVID-19 recovery status

- a. For passengers with COVID-19 recovery between 14-90 days after the first date of symptom or first date of the positive test; no vaccination is needed.
- b. If a passenger holds a Covid-19 recovery certificate, which lasts longer than 90 days, a single dose of vaccine will be accepted as being fully vaccinated.
