



Tourism is now permitted from India to Germany

- Fully vaccinated persons (Covishield) are allowed to enter Germany. Last vaccination dose must be at least 14 days before the date of travel
- The vaccination certificate must reflect the passport number/date of birth of the traveler which can be done on the Cowin app
- Alternatively, the WHO vaccination booklet with vaccination details
- Travelers who have recovered from Covid-19 need to prove receiving one dose of vaccine (Covishield) and show proof of having contracted Covid
- Unvaccinated children under 12 years of age accompanied by a fully vaccinated parent can enter Germany with no quarantine

Departure regulations for travelers from India entering Germany

- Passport number /DOB needs to be updated on the Vaccination Certificate
- Proof of a full COVID-19 vaccination (Covishield) or proof of recovery from Covid (not less than 28 days and not longer than 6 months) with old +ve test result + proof of recovery from a doctor + proof of 1 dose of vaccine
- Negative COVID-19 test result (not mandatory if fully vaccinated)
RTPCR - no more than 72 hours prior to entry (time of swabbing) or
RAT - no more than 48 hours prior to entry
- No quarantine for fully vaccinated or recovered persons

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
