

Dear Travel Partners,

We are pleased to inform you that eligible passengers from India can travel directly with us destined to Kuwait as per the below guidelines

### TRAFFIC INDIA to KUWAIT

**For points 1- 4 bookings to be waitlisted by KAC offices/agents and documents to be submitted for verification with Kuwait Airways Local offices prior to confirmation of the PNR & ticket issuance.**

1. Employees of the Ministry of Health and their first degree relative (Husband/Wife & Children) vide DGCA Circular # 103
  - Employees in possession of a valid residency or a valid entry permit, are allowed to travel to the State of Kuwait
  - First degree relative of MOH employee(Husband/Wife/Children): Should submit the proof of relation. Concerned must verify the MOH employee Civil ID copy with the supporting document submitted by the passenger.
  - Civil ID copy of MOH Employee
  - Marriage Certificate or Both passports (husband and wife) contain Spouse's name
  - Birth Certificate for children's or Passport contains parent's name.
2. Kuwaiti citizens Allowed traveling to the State of Kuwait
3. Employees of the Private Medical Sector in the State of Kuwait those names listed in the attachment with DGCA Circular # 104 are allowed to travel to the State of Kuwait provided if they are in possession of a valid residency
4. Domestic Help under article 20 permitted to travel if is accompanied by the sponsor on the flight.
5. Domestic Help under "Article 20" if travelling alone, then all *travel arrangements including ticket issuance to be done through the link only and KAC local offices have no role to play* - <https://Belsalamah.com>

**All passengers must obtain a RT-PCR negative certificate from an accredited health center.**

- i. Validity of the PCR certificate should be within 96 hours upon arrival.
  - a. Children's under six (6) years old are exempted from performing the PCR test.

5. Passenger showing any symptoms of COVID-19 or High Temperature should not be accepted on the flight to Kuwait.

6. All passengers should install **"Shlonik"** application on their personal device (smartphones) and must sign into the application and **update all required information** before boarding the flight. (Excluding pax traveling on ARTICLE 20 )

7. All arriving passengers will be subject to a 14 days home quarantine.

8. Human Remains with cause of death due to COVID-19 is not allowed.

a. No exceptions for any nationalities including Kuwaiti.
