Effective 1 February 2023: a new form for carrying animals in the cabin

If you intend to carry an animal as hand luggage (PETC) or an assistance dog (SVAN) onboard, you need to submit a confirmation that the animal meets all requirements. Please inform your customers at the booking time starting 1 February 2023; they must present two printouts of the fully completed and signed form at the check-in counter.

AVIH Embargo for the transport of American Bulldogs

Starting 1 February 2023, the transport of the dog breed "American Bulldog" in the cargo hold (AVIH) is no longer permitted. This applies to all flights operated by Austrian Airlines, Brussels Airlines, Lufthansa, SWISS, and Air Dolomiti.

Reducing the carbon footprint with AeroSHARK

The Lufthansa Group will be the first airline group in the world to equip more than 20 long-haul aircraft in its fleet with aerodynamic sharkskin film. The film is modelled on the microscopic structure of shark skin and applied to the aircraft's outer skin. It directly reduces aircraft drag, cuts kerosene consumption, and thus reduces the Lufthansa Group's carbon footprint by more than 25,000 tons annually.
